INTRODUCTION

- Answer some general questions about Spain.
- Turn in all of the information requested along with pictures of your findings.

- Describe what you will be learning and doing at this school. (classes, extra-curricular's, sports, etc.)

- 4) What cities do you want to visit? (choose four)
- 5) What is today's weather in each of those cities?
- 6) What tourist attraction would you visit there?
- 7) How much will it cost to go to the attraction?
